That same weekend is registration for Religious Education classes for all children of the parish who are between first and eighth grade and who are not in our parish school or a Catholic home school.

On Friday 26 August and Saturday 27 August we'll host the conference on "The Prophet and the Messiah: Catholicism and the Challenge of Islam" sponsored by the Center for Evangelical Catholicism.


On Tuesday 6 September and Wednesday 7 September we'll have the return of the Program of Catholic Studies.

After the Holy Eucharist, the most important form of Christian prayer is the Liturgy of the Hours, also called the Divine Office. In the Roman form of the Divine Office there are two liturgical Hours for the evening: Vespers and Compline. In the 16th century Book of Common Prayer, these two Hours were combined into one celebration called Evensong, and this beautiful way of praying is part of the Anglican patrimony preserved in the Catholic Church by the Personal Ordinariates for Catholics from the Anglican tradition. 
