Dear Friends in Christ,

The new fiscal year for our parish will begin on 1 July, so it's time to talk about our finances. For the fiscal year just ending, we will have a small surplus over our budgeted target, and given the chaos in which we have lived for the past year and a half, that is an extraordinary accomplishment. I am deeply grateful to everyone who contributed during this past year and made it possible for us to pay all of our bills, to assist those in need, to maintain our school, to provide services of many kinds to our people, to help our mission congregation at San Sebastian, and to do our part in sustaining the ministry of our bishop and the Diocese of Charleston. Thank you for your generosity.

As has been the case for the past twenty years, our budget for the new fiscal year is based on an increase of 2% in offertory giving, and so I am once again asking every household in the parish to increase your contributions to the primary offertory by 2% over last fiscal year. This means that if you were giving \$50 per week until now, then your new target is \$51, and if you were giving \$125 per week, your new target is \$127.50. If everyone makes this modest adjustment of 2% to all offertory gifts, then we will once again make our budget goal right on the money.

We are, of course, still living with economic uncertainty from the coronavirus, and there seems to be a real risk of inflation in the coming months. So in the year ahead we will exercise even greater caution than usual in all of our financial decisions, and I will keep you posted each week in the bulletin with our actual collections measured against our budgeted needs. Thank you for whatever you can give.

Our Forward in Faith Capital Campaign continues, and we are making steady progress towards our goal of \$7 million. We have collected just over \$3.6 million in gifts and have received another \$900,000 in pledges. That leaves us with a goal for new donations of \$2.5 million to raise before the end of 2023, and depending on the cost of construction for our projects, we may need to revise that number up. Remember that our campaign is for four main projects: 1) the diocesan bicentennial campaign, 2) the construction of a new building to serve as a practice gym and social hall that will also provide a temporary home for Mass while we do the work for, 3) the construction of an annex to the church to provide indoor rest rooms and accessible confessionals, and 4) significant repairs to the church interior including new fan coil units for our HVAC system, new wood wainscoting for the side aisles, new pews and kneelers, patching and painting plaster walls, and badly needed improvements to our organ.

We long ago fulfilled our portion of the diocesan campaign and will soon be getting updated numbers on the other projects. For now, thank you for your sacrificial commitment to St Mary's.

The *Real Love & Real Life* retreat is presented by Family Honor Inc., an organization that has provided and promoted a family-centered Catholic approach to chastity education since 1988. # Offertory Envelopes and the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Marriage



If you no longer receive weekly stewardship envelopes in the mail, you may have been marked as **Inactive** within our parishioner database. No matter how often

you come to Mass at St Mary's, you are not considered an **Active** member of the parish unless you are registered here, attending Mass here each Sunday, and using the stewardship envelopes to fulfill two separate purposes: a) making your offertory contributions and other gifts, and b) establishing an attendance record.

## Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition in the school
- ◆ Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, Confirmation, or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either here at St Mary's or in another parish)

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box for EFT on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection plate. All envelopes in the collection are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as <u>Inactive</u> and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes again, please email Sarah Perkins at sarah.perkins@stmarysgvl.org

## **Baptism Class**



Prior to having a child baptized at Saint Mary's, you must have been registered in the parish for at least six months, attending Sunday Mass each week, using the stewardship envelopes, and participating in the life of the parish.
