Dear Friends in Christ,

The new fiscal year for our parish will begin on 1 July, so it's time to talk about our finances. For the fiscal year just ending, we have a small surplus over our budget, but because of the high inflation that has prevailed for two years now, that surplus has already been expended on general costs for operations. So we broke even this year, and that is good news.

For the new fiscal year, the cost for insuring our buildings will be rising over 15% because of several years of no or low increases and because of the recent significant rise in the cost of construction. At the same time, our costs for health insurance for our employees have gone up 3%, and we also provided a cost of living adjustment of 3% to all staff.

For all of these reasons, I am once again asking all households in the parish to increase your offertory contributions by 3% beginning now. This means that if you were giving \$50 per week until now, then your new target would be \$51.50. And if you were giving \$125 per week, then your new target is \$128.75, and so on. If everyone makes this adjustment of 3% to all offertory gifts, then we will once again make our budget goal and be able to fulfill all our financial responsibilities.

There are early signs that the general inflation rate is falling back towards the usual pattern of the last twenty years, and so I hope that this will be the last time I need to ask you for a 3% increase in your giving. And in any case, please know that we do everything we can to live within our means and use your gifts to make Saint Mary's a green and pleasant corner of the vineyard for everyone who comes here seeking the Lord.

Construction on our new gym and hall is going very well, and we expect to open this beautiful new facility in October. We will soon be advertising naming opportunities for those who want to help us provide a dignified space for recreation, social activities, meetings, and holiday Masses, and once you see the Clinkscales Family Gymnasium up close, I am sure you will agree that it was worth the wait.

We still need your help to complete our current capital campaign, Forward in Faith, which will end this December. Our regular capital campaigns are the primary way we maintain, enhance, and expand our buildings and grounds to create and sustain an inviting campus in the heart of downtown Greenville. And please recall our stewardship guidelines for your tithe: 5% to the parish in offertory gifts, 1% to the diocese in the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina (formerly the BAA), and the remaining 4% to charities of your choice, including our capital campaigns.

The careful stewardship of time, talent, and treasure is an essential part of authentic Christian discipleship, and I am deeply grateful for your sacrificial commitment to Saint Mary's.







Offertory Envelopes and the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Marriage



If you no longer receive weekly stewardship envelopes in the mail, you may have been marked as **Inactive** within our parishioner database. No matter how often you

come to Mass at St Mary's, you are not considered an **Active** member of the parish unless you are registered here, attending Mass here each Sunday, and using the stewardship envelopes to fulfill two separate purposes: a) making your offertory contributions and other gifts, and b) establishing an attendance record.

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- ◆ Parishioner tuition in the school
- ◆ Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- Baptism, Confirmation, or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children, either here at St Mary's or in another parish)

If you use electronic transfer to make your offertory contribution and other gifts, simply check the box for EFT on the empty envelope and then drop it in the collection plate. All envelopes in the collection are recorded in our parish database.

Once six months elapses without any envelopes or online donations received, the account is marked as <u>Inactive</u> and envelopes are no longer distributed. To begin receiving stewardship envelopes again, please email Sarah Perkins at sarah.perkins@smcgvl.org.

Baptism Class



Prior to having a child baptized at Saint Mary's, you must have been registered in the parish for at least six months, attending Sunday Mass each week, using the stewardship envelopes, and

participating in the life of the parish. Baptisms take place on Saturdays at 6.15 pm after the 5.00 pm Mass. Attending a Baptism Preparation Class is required and may be attended prior to the birth of your child. The next scheduled class is Monday 11 September.
