General Information:

The mission of St. Mary's Council of Catholic Women is to respond with Gospel values to the needs of the Church and society in the modern world. It strives to support, empower, and educate all Catholic women in spirituality, leadership, and service. This Scholarship was, therefore, created to encourage and promote such themes among Catholic females.

Eligibility Requirements:

An applicant must be female member of St. Mary's Catholic Church who is a graduating senior from a high school program within South Carolina and planning to attend an institution of higher education (e.g., university, college, junior college, or technical school).

- Applicants must be a Catholic in good standing
- The applicant must be recommended by a priest, brother, deacon, woman religious, or youth minister.
- Application and associated documents must be received by the deadline. No late applications will be considered.

Submission MUST Include:

A completed application signed by *both* the student and a guardian.

- A high school transcript.
- A copy of the university/college/school acceptance letter—only ONE is required.
- A letter of recommendation from an ecclesiastical body.
- An essay, not more than two typed pages, on the topic, "What part will spirituality, leadership, and service play in my life in the future?"

Submission must be postmarked on or before 15 April 2025 to be considered.
